Call for projects - Startup YMCA Bootcamp

We're launching a Call for Projects for all YMCA Youth groups aged 18-30 with no limits on the number of young people that can participate. The selected projects will be chosen to participate in Startup YMCA Bootcamp, without any associated expenses at the location (including accommodation and food). The cost of transportation has to be supported by the participants or their local branches of YMCA.

The bootcamp will be on June 4th, 5th and 6th at YMCA Alambre Camp in Setúbal, Portugal.

The StartUp YMCA Bootcamp will provide a chance to generate, discuss, and implement innovative solutions to address social and environmental challenges by launching a project or launching a social enterprise. We're convinced that the global involvement of YMCA's youth (aged 18-30) will make a difference, not only inside the organization, but also take those projects back home and make an impact in our communities.

Applications

From February to April applicants need to fill in a online form. You also need to send us your Europass CV and a project description (if you have one already).

For groups, there is a limit of 2 people per group/project.

Applicant's Profile

Age: from 18 to 30 years old.

Good level of English: mandatory, for the Bootcamp's official language will be English.

We are looking for people with new ideas and the will to make change happen through social entrepreneurship with a sustainable business model. Everyone is free to apply to this Open Call and attend the bootcamp.

As we choose whitin the applicants, we value the applicant's experience in social work (or YMCA volunteers) and the applicant's knowledge or practice in business.

YMCA Setúbal

The YMCA was founded in Setúbal in 1905 under the name of the Christian Youth Union, and in 1920 it became the Christian Youth Association (YMCA). From 1930 onwards, during the dictatorship, the association was forgotten and remained dormant until 1975, when Dr. Mário de Melo Pereira returned to give life to the YMCA. In 2017, at a Board meeting, the new statutes were approved, adopting the international acronym YMCA, by which we are known in the more than 120 countries where we are present.

YMCA Setúbal is an IPSS (Private Institution of Social Solidarity) that employs about 100 people, and is located in <u>6</u> <u>Centers</u> spread throughout the Municipality of Setúbal. It develops a wide variety of programs including camps, support for community families, food bank, social actions, gyms, swimming lessons, as well as children's programs for nursery, kindergarten and leisure activity centers, vocational training and apprenticeship center. The latest addition to our programs is StartUp YMCA.





YMCA Setúbal Camp Alambre


The space where the YMCA Camp Alambre is located was designed to be the gateway to Arrábida Mountain Range. It was created in 1998 by the Institute for Nature Conservation and Forests (ICNF), with the aim of raising awareness of nature preservation and valuing protected areas as places of high national interest, as is the case of the Arrábida Natural Park.

In 2008, the YMCA, with the support of the ICNF, became a managing and investing entity in the recovery of the bungalows and the Environmental Park.
